Whereas there was formerly surveyed to our late Father a large Tract of land in the County of Philadelphia called the Mannor of Gilberts; These are to authorize and require thee to resurvey and return the same according to the ancient bounds & limits thereof into the Secretary's Office with a particular & exact account of what lands may heretofore have been survey'd thereout & to whom. Given under my Hand & the Lesser Seal of our Province at Philadelphia this twelfth day of February Anno Dom. 1733.
