Copy D^d. These are to authorize and require thee to survey & lay out unto the s^d John Roberts the s^d several quantities of land amounting to two hundred and fifty acres in one tract where not already survey'd nor taken up nor concealed nor seated by y^e Indians to be held at & under y^e yearly rent of one half penny sterl. \textsterling acre and make returns thereof into y^e General Surveyor's office where this warrant^r is to remain and a copy thereof to be deliv'd to thee certified by y^e Secretary Given under our hands and Seals of y^e Province at Philad^{ia} the 17th of y^e 6th moth 1702.
