I do hereby certify that I have surveyed & laid out to the 5^d Proprietaries Nephew William Penn Esq^r the lot of Ground in the High Street of the City Philad^a Appurtenant to his Father's purchase of five thousand acres. Bounded on the south by High Street on the West by the Eighth Street from Delaware River on the north by the back ends of Mulberry Street Lots on the east by a vacant lot contain^g in breadth on the 5^d High Street 132 f^t and in Length on the 5^d eighth Street 306 f^t Surveyed y^e 25th day of the 1st M^o (March) 1734 and Returned into the Secretary's Office the 26th day of y^e same M^o.
