to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye sd County  
where not taken up according to ye method of Townships app-  
ointed by me & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 17<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> mo. 1683.
