Whereas by virtue of a Warrant by us granted the 22^d day of May last a small tract of land in the County of Chester lying between the Manor of Bilton Pickering's Creek & the River Skuylkill was surveyed & a return thereof made but the lines of the said tract not being sufficiently described.

These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to resurvey the said tract and make an exact return thereof into the Secretary's office.
