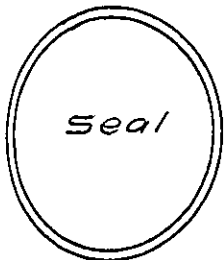

grant her to take up ten thousand acres of land her remain-
ing due of fifty thousand acres by me granted to her Mother.*

*These are to require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be
survey'd to my sd Daughter the sd number of ten thousand
acres in one or more convenient Tracts in any County or
Counties of this Province and make due returns thereof into
my Secretaries office.*

*Given under my hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 15th
day of the 7th moth 1701.*
