



Upon a late agreement made with the prop^r. this tract of land was divided between Thomas McKean 260 acres and 150 perches, William Wilson 260 acres and 150 perches situate in Calm Township in the County of Chester being in the whole 521 acres & 140 perches which was laid ^{out} for the Proprietors use for 500 acres on the 30th of June 1703.

By virtue of a general Warr^t from the late Prop^r dated the 1st of 7^{ber} 1700 to lay out for the use of himself & his heirs &c ye quant^y of 500 acs in every Town^{sh} of 5000 acres in this province agreeable to the primitive regulation in laying out lands &c. Benja. Mendinhalls part returned &c ye 27th of April 1741. A Warr^t issued ye 25th of March 1741 to establish the resurv^y & division made to W^m Wilson & Tho^s McKean & to make returns &c. They having assigned to Benja. & Aaron Mendinhal the returns were made in ye sd. B. & A. Mendinhalls names as afores^d

12th X 1737 p^d by them together £ 60. --

My Frd. B. E. I desire thee to send the quantity of the above land making the usual allowance of 6 per Cent Thine J. S.
