



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Springtown Manor in the County of Chester now in the possession of Andrew Willson beginning at a marked black oak a corner of land belonging to the heirs of Francis Long dec'd thence by the same S. 88° W. 154 perches to a marked Spanish Oak. Thence by land of Samuel Muckledorff North 36 perches to a marked Poplar S. 88° W. 29 perches to a stone and North 98 perches to a stone in the Manor line thence by the same East by North 74 perches to a marked Poplar thence by land of John McFeeters N. 66 E. 114 perches to a marked hickery thence William Mackey's land S. 6 E. 45 perches to a stone thence by the same & land of James McKoskry South 147 perches to the place of beginning containing one hundred & sixty four acres and 129 perches & allowance of 6 feet for Roads &c
