



Pursuant to a letter from William Peters Esq^r dated 27th of Nov^r 1764 to me directed ^{to} resurvey & regulate part of the Prop^r land joining Pikesis line between Eriffith Jones & Jonathan Wells. I accordingly tryed, the lines and found a mistake in the division line between sd Jones & Wells owing to a new line made part of the way thro. sd Jones's land, which was return'd in a former Draught mentioning a Chesnut & Hicory for corners of sd Jones's land which measured but 111 perches, tho returned 119 upon acct^s his Deed spacefying that number of perches which extending to the true line gives that number exactly.

The piece marked A being the part belonging to Jonathan Wells contains eight acres one quarter & six perches with usual allowances,

The piece marked B the part belonging to Eriffith Jones contains twelve acres and sixteen perches with usual allowances.
