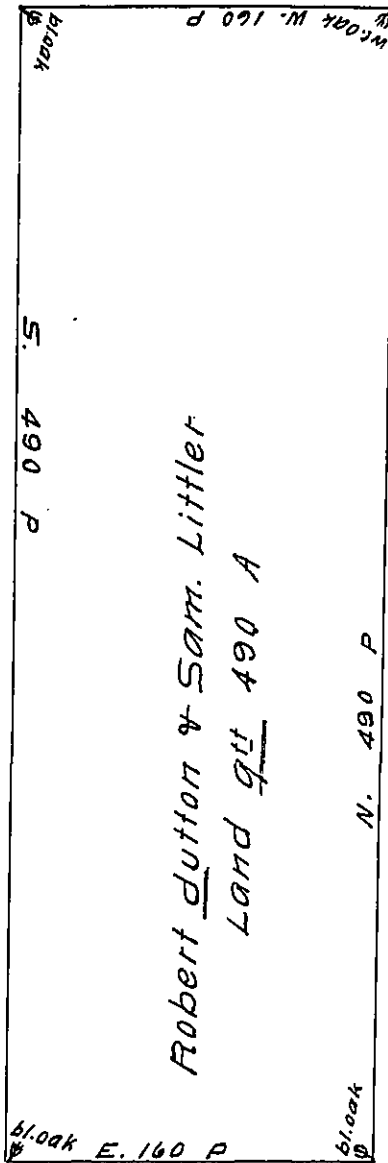


WILL BROWN LAND



Barren lott or Common lott

By virtue of a Warrant to me directed dated ye 7th 1st m 1701. Surd for Robert Dutton and Samuel Littler a tract of land in Nottingham begining A-A corner black oak being a corner of a tract of land in Common to the Nottingham Company thend by ye sd. Commons N. 490 pch to a corner white oak thence West 160 pch to a corner hickery being a corner of William Browns land then by his line South 490 pch to a corner black oak then Est 160 pch to the place of begining containing 490 acrs of land the 11th 3rd m 1702.
