survayed unto James Brown a tract of land in Nottingham begining at a corner spanish oak being a corner of Will-Browns land thence North 490 pch to a corner post thencobl West 160 pch to a corner black oak being a corner of James Coopers land thence South 490 pch to a corner hickery thence Est 160 pch to the place of begining containing 490 acres of land the 11<sup>th</sup> d-m. 1702
