



By virtue of a Warrant to me directed dated ye 7th day of ye first month 1701.

I have survd unto Ebenezer Empson a tract of land in Nottingham begining at a corner black oak being a corner of William Browns land thence by his line North 490 perch to a corner post thence West 160 perch—to a corner white oak being a corner of the Prop'y land thence South 490 perch to a corner white oak thence Est 160 perch to the place of begining containing 490 acres of land ye 10th day 3^m. 1702
