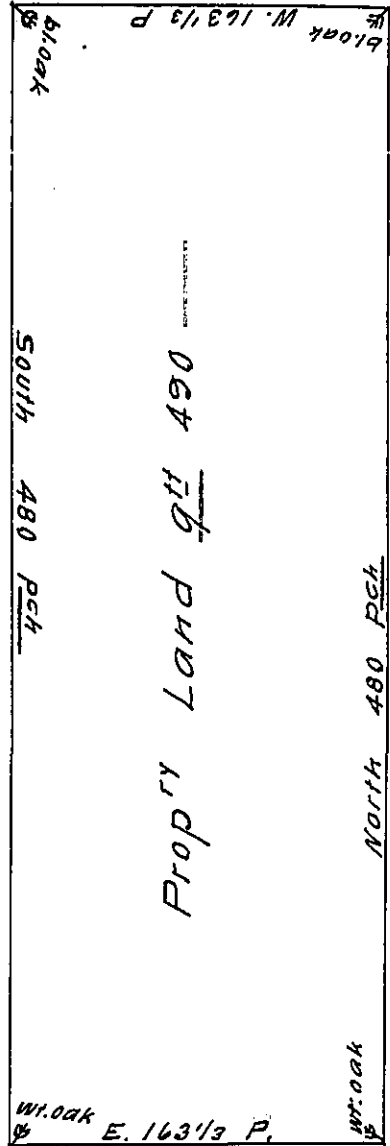


JOHN RICHARDSON LAND



Cornelius Empson land

By virtue of a Warrant to mee directed dated ye 7th 1-m. 1701.

I have surv^d unto the Prop^{ty} a tract of land ^{situate} in Nottingham begining at a corner white oak being a corner of Cornelius Empsons land thence by his line North 480 perch— to a corner black oak thence West 163 1/3 perch to a corner black oak being a corner of John Richardsons land then by his line South 480 perch to a corner white oak thence— East 163 1/3 perch to the place of begining containing 490 acres the 14th 3-m. 1702.
