I have surveyed unto Henry Randls a tract of land in Nottingham beginning at a black oak being a corner of John Richardsons land thence by his land N. 480 perch to a white oak thence W. 181 perch to a white oak thence South 214 perch to a corner beech then East 31 perch to a post being a corner of the Govt land thence by his line 266 perch to a corner post then East 150 perch to ye place of beginning containing 490 acres the 13<sup>th</sup> day of the third month 1702
