

At the request of Joseph Pike by his Attorney Thomas Story that I would grant him a resurvey on ten thousand acres of land being part of a tract of thirty thousand acres laid out to 5! Matthias Vincent & Company in the County of Chester.

These are to will and require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd to him the said ten thousand acres, run-ning lines of division about the same and make returns thereof into my Secretaries office.

Given under my hand and seal at Pensbury the 29th day of the 6th month 1700
