

Pursuant to a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the
— day of the — month 171— there was surveyed unto John Retar
on the West of Schuylkill in the county of Chester one hundred &
sixty two acres of land beginning at a black oak at a corner
of other land of the said John Retar and running by the same
North East four hundred ninety perches to the River Schuylkill thence
down the same on the courses thereof to a black oak by the said
river then South West by a line of marked trees four hundred &
eighty perches to a white oak, then North West fifty five perches to
the begining containing one hundred & sixty two acres with allowance
and an Island in the said River containing four or five acres.
The said Island lyes over against the sd land
