



By virtue of a Warrant from the Prop<sup>rs</sup> Comm<sup>rs</sup> I survey'd to Joseph Cloud of Cone obl a certain tract of land scituate on a branch of Pequea Creek in the County of Chester.

Begining at a corner Marked black oak being a corner of Rebecka Shaw's land thence N. E. by N. by the same land 139 perches to a white oak thence North East by the land of James Logan 250 perches to a post thence South East by ye land of Thomas Clark 302 perches to a post thence West South West by vacant land 417 pches to a post thence North West by the land of James Clemson 121 perches to the place of begining containing five hundred acres with the allowance of six Per cent. Survey'd the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1717
