These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause Steager to be surveyed to the said Jacob Steager according to the method of townships the said quantity of one hundred and fifty acres of vacant land in the place aforesaid and make return thereof into the Secretarys office which survey in case the said Jacob fulfill the above agreement shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if the same had never been made nor this Warr^t ever granted. Given under our Hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 15th day of ye 12th month A.D. 1717/8.
