By the Commissioners of Property

L. 5. At the request of Jacob Knave that we would grant him to take up two hundred acres of land on the west of Skuylkill near that tract which was seated by Peter Bizaillon and for some time possessed by Mathew Brooks for which he agrees to pay two and thirty pounds for the whole in one year after the date hereof with six months interest for the same and the yearly quittance of one shilling sterling ~~per~~ hundred forever. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed to the said Jacob Knave according to the method of townships the said quantity of two hundred acres of vacant land in the place aforesaid and make returns thereof into the Secretary's office which survey ^{case} in the said Jacob fulfill the above agreement shall be valid otherwise the same shall be void as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted, given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 15th day of the 12th month A.D. 1717/8
