At the request of Hubert Cassel that we would grant him to take up two hundred & fifty acres of land on the West side of Shuylkill near that tract which was ~~settled~~ seated by Peter Bizailon and for some time possessed by Mathew Brooks for which he agrees to pay forty pounds for the whole in one year after the date thereof with six months interest for the same and the yearly quit rent of one shilling sterling ~~per~~ hundred forever. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cau— to be survey'd to the said Hubert Cassel according to the method of townships the said quantity of two Hubert hundred & fifty acres of vacant land in the place afore said and make Cassel return thereof into the Secretaries office with which agreement if 250 the said Hubert shall duly comply ~~in~~ this survey shall be valid other acres wise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 15th day of the 12th month A.D. 1717/8
