Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye request of Evan Oliver yt I would grant him to take up
his proportion of land wthin ye liberties out of two hundred acres & yt I
might let him take up six more joynt^{ly} thereunto at rent.

These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be
survey'd unto him ten acres of land as near to ye place where he
now lives upon ^{as may be} and make returns thereof into my Secretarys
office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 16th 5th mo. 1684.
