

October the 23<sup>d</sup> 1717 then surveyd to Hance Kaigey by virtue of the Commissioners Warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 1717 a piece of land at Conestogo in the County of Chester beginning at a post standing in a ~~line~~ line of Melker Penerman's land and at a corner of Thomas Simons's land thence South by East by the said Thomas Simons land 107 perches to a post thence West by South 136 to a small hickery thence North by West one hundred and eleven perches to a post thence East North East 141 perches to the place of beginning containing one hundred (46) acres
