By vertue of severall warts from the Proprietary & Governobl. of this Province &c. to me directed and dated the 6th instanobl. to survey unto Jn^o Haselgrove five hundred acres, unto Joseph Phipps three hundred acres, unto Georg- Thomson, Thomas Hall, ~~unto~~ Robert Adams, James Brown, Nathaniel Parkes, Jn^o Hinlebert, Andrew Marklewere, Jeremy Collet, Jn^o Beale & Georg-Strode each of them two hundred acres a peece and all in the townshipp of Concord in the County of Chester as also unto W^m Collet & Mary Meers one hundred acres a peece in the said townshipp. And ^{& all in the townshipp of Concord & County of Chester} also unto Jn^o Minehall, three hundred acres, unto Jn^o Kingsman, Jn^o Harding & W^m Hiscock, two hundred and fifty acres a peece in the remaining part of the said townshipp of Concord, and ^{unto Phillip yomane 250^a unto Francis Chadsey 200^a} also, unto Mary White one hundred twenty five acres in the next Townshipp to the said townshipp of Concord & County aforesaid alwaies observing the method and rule ordered and appointed by the Govern^t and to make me a true returne herof both of the originall field work and protracted figure which by my pattent are to remain in my office: Dated this 11th of 12th month 1682.
