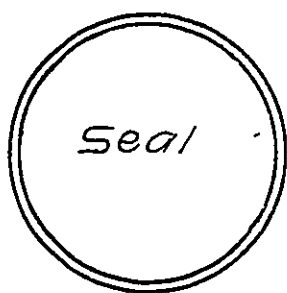

*At the request of Evan Owen of the City of Philad<sup>ia</sup> that we would grant him to take up ten acres of land within the liberties of the said City in right and as part of a grant of five hundred acres made by the Proprietor to George Whitehead with which the said Evan — is now legally invested as by our warr<sup>t</sup> of even date ~~h~~herewith for the other 490 acres more fully appears. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the said Evan Owen in the right aforesaid the said quantity of ten acres of land within the said liberties beyond the River Skuykill that is vacant and not appropriated and make a return thereof into the Secretaries office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month A.D. 171<sup>5</sup>/<sub>6</sub>*
