Quantity from ye Proprietary. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out for the sd Joseph Pike the said quantity of One thousand Acres of Land that hath not been already survey'd nor taken up, nor Concealed nor Seated by the Indians and make Returns Into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by ye Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} 24th day of Novemb^r 1702.
