These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the said John Scarborough a Lott proportionable to the said Purchase in the fifth Street from Delaware - as conveniently as may be where Vacant or untaken up and make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warrt is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary.
