By vertue of a wart from ye Proprieta^r and Govern^r bearing date ye 5th of ye 4th moneth last (directed to me) I hereby sertifie into his Secretary's office yt I have caused to be surveyd and set out unto Nicholas Moore purchaser his City lib^{rty} lott ye 25⁻ of ye said mo^y. Begining at a marked white oke standing by Cohoehinck Creek running up ye said Creek N. N. E. 20 perches y^e North twenty perches, y^e North North East twenty perches, then North forty six perches, then North West and by West sixty perches, then North North West twenty perches to a marked read oak standing by ye said Creek from thenc^e West and by South one hundred and forty perches to a corn^r stak^e then South South West $\frac{1}{4}$ Westerly sixty eⁱght perches to a marked stake from thence South East and by South twenty seaven perches to a corner marked ~~corner~~ White oake standing by a small Runn from thenc^e South East one hundred and fouerty perches by ye said Runn then East North East eⁱghty fouer perches to ye first marked white oak containing two hundred acres and is bounded Northward with vacant land Eastward with ye land of Shakamaxunck southward and Westward wth ye land of Daniell Pegg and Comp^{ys} and is accordingly entred and recorded in my office Philadelphia this 4th of ye 4th month 1684
