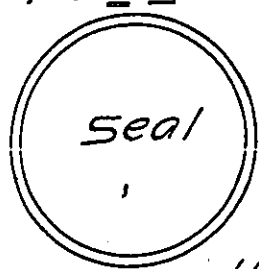

Upon an agreement now made with Hans George Schutz & Matthias Ringer lately arrived here from Germany for five hundred acres of land situate on west side of the River Schuylkill where Peter Bizailon formerly dwelt for which they agree to pay to the Proprietors us one hundred pounds money of Pennsylvania for the whole & the yearly quit rent of one shilling sterling for every hundred acres.

These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Hans George Schutz & Matthias Ringer in the place aforesaid according to the method of townships appointed the quantity of five hundred acres of land including within the said survey the Plantation & improvements where the said Peter — dwelt and make returns thereof into the Secretarys office which said survey in case the said Hans George — & Matthias — or either of them pay down upon the return of the said survey now immediately be made forty pounds and the remaining sixty pounds on the sixteenth day of November next ensuing after ye date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted.
