

Pursuant to a Warrant from Samuel Carpenter Richard Hill and Isaac Norris Commissioners of Property Sealed with the Provincial Seal dated the 30th day of 5^{mo} 1712 I have Surveyd and Laid out this 3^d day of April 1716 unto James Logan of the City of Philad^a Esquire in Right of Henry Geary's Purchase of five hundred acres of Land in this Province, One lot of Ground in the said City in breadth Ninety nine foot and in Length two hundred fifty five foot bounded Northward with Chestnut Street Eastward with the Sixth Street from the River Delaware on the South with Walnut street lots and on the West with the Lot next herein after mentioned As also one Lot (in Right of John Geary's Purchase of five hundred acres) of the same Dimensions viz^t Ninety nine foot in breadth and two hundred & fifty five foot in Length bounded Northward with Chestnut street Eastward with the Lot last above Described Southward with Walnut Street lots and Westward with the Lot next herein after Mentioned And One Lot (in Right of Samuel Noyes's Purchase of five hundred acres) of the same Dimensions with the former viz^t Ninety nine foot in Breadth and two hundred fifty five foot ^{in Length} bounded on the North with the said Chestnut street on the East with the Lot last above Described on the South with Walnut Street Lots and on the West with _____
