

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property (viz: Samuel Carpenter Richard Hill and Isaac Norris) and the Provincial Seal dated the 30th day of y^e 5th Month 1712 Authorizing me to Survey unto James Logan of Philadelphia Merch: the Liberty Land and City lots in Right of Several Original Purchases (in the said Warrant mentioned) amounting to Six thousand acres Surveyd and Laid out the 3^d day of the 2^d Mo: April to the said James Logan One Lot in Right of Henry Geary's Purchase of five hundred acres One lot in Right of John Geary's Purchase of five hundred and One Lot in Right of Samuel Noys his Purchase of five hundred acres Which three Lots lying Contiguous are Bounded on the North with Chesnut Street on the East with the Sixth Street from Delaware on the South with ^{the} Ends of Walnut street Lots on the West with a Vacant Lot Each Lot being in Breadth Ninety nine foot (making in the whole on Chesnut Street two hundred Ninety Seven foot) and in Length two hundred fifty five foot
