Whereas James Logan hath made Appear to us That he is possessed of y^e whole Right of Two thousand five hundred Acres of Land Granted by y^e Proprietor to Hugh Larrib of London Hosier by Deeds dated y^e 14th & 15th of Septem^{ber} 1681 & Two thousand Acres Granted by y^e Propriet^r to Edw^d Bettris of Oxford Chirurgeon by Deeds dated y^e 13 & 14 of October 1681 and to Two thousand five hundred Acres being one Moiety of five thousand Acres Granted by y^e Proprietor to Matthew Marks by Deeds dated y^e 22^d & 23^d of August 1682 w^{ho} conveyd y^e same to Rich^d Heyries Merch^t of Londⁿ w^{ho} sold y^e aforesaid Moiety, & is at this time possessed of y^e other As also of y^e Right of five hundred Acres Granted by y^e Propriet^r to Henry Geary of Chesam in Bucks, dated y^e 4th & 5th dayes of April 1682 and of five hundred Acres Granted by y^e Propriet^r to Jm^s Geary of Durisloe in Hertfordshire by Deeds of y^e same Date with y^e last Mentiond As also of y^e Right to the Liberty Land & City Lot^t belonging to Purchase of five hundred Acres had of y^e Propriet^r by Saml^l Noyes of y^e Devises in y^e County of Wilts by Deed dated y^e 1st & 2^d dayes of August 1681 for y^e Liberty Land & Lot^ts belonging to w^{ch} said Purchases, he hath requested us that We would Grant him our Warr^{ts}. These therefore are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyd to y^e s^d James Logan y^e just Proportion of Land belonging to all y^e herein before recited Purchases being Eight thousand five hundred Acres in y^e whole, taking into y^e said Survey according to y^e Proprietors Order if need be, that Tract of Land beyond Skuykill recorded by y^e Propriet^r from y^e estate of Rob^t Longshore for Eighty Acres of Land taken up by y^e said Rob^t in the s^d Liberties on Delaware side, Also to survey & lay out to y^e said James. All y^e Lot^ts within y^e City of Philad^{ia} belonging to y^e said Purchases either in y^e same places where they Originally were Allotted or as near to the same as conveniently may be, & make Returns of all y^e aforesaid Land in the City Liberties, & Lot^ts within y^e said City either together or apart as there shall be Occasion into y^e Secretaries Office Given und^r our hands & Seal of y^e Province at
