



By Virtue of a Warr^t from Jacob Taylor Survey^r: Gen^l: to me directed bearing date the 24th of 7th mo^r 1713, Pursuant to a Warr^t from the Commissioners of Property dated the 30th of the 5th month 1712 to lay out unto James Logan two thousand acres of Land in Right of Edward Bettris of Oxford Chyrurgeon; Surveyed & Laid out unto the s^d James Logan a tract of Land in Hilton township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Heap of Stones between a black oak & a white oak both marked, being also a Corner of Jeremiah Longhorns Land, from thence running North West by vacant Land four hundred seventytwo perches to another heap of Stones, Then North East by Vacant Land three hundred & Sixty perches to a Post, Then South East by John Pettis Manor four hundred seventy two perches to a Hickory tree, Then by the s^d Jeremiah Longhorns Line South West three hundred & Sixty perches to the place of beginning Containing one thousand acres with Allowance at Six p Cent: according to Law; Laid out the 10th day of the 3^d month Anno Domini 1714.
