



By virtue of a Warrant from Jacob Taylor Survey: Genl to me directed bearing date the twelveth day of December 1713 Surveyed & laid out unto James Logans a tract of Land in Hilton township in Bucks County Beginning at a Post at the North Corner of his other land, from thence running South West by his other laid, five hundred sixty five perches & an half to small white Oak marked for a Corner, Then by vacant Land North West three hundred perches to a Post by a black Oak marked on one side, Then by the Servants township North East five hundred sixty five perches & an half to a Post, Then by John Pettit's Marrow South East three hundred perches to the place of beginning Containing one thousand acres (with allowance as the Law directs) laid out the tenth day of the third month 1714.
