



There being surveyed many years ago to James Logan Esq: a Tract of Land on French Creek in Chester County containing by Computation 1000° & the same afterw^{ds} confirmed to him by Patent: A great part whereof was reported to be poor rocky Land, such as no purchaser would have taken up at the time that Survey was made, considering at what distance it lies from Town. Whereupon the Proprietor ordered that 700° of the worst should be cut of & Released by the s^d James Logan, in lieu whereof he should have 700° granted him within Comestogoe Mannor. To the 300° remaining after the afores^d 700° was cut of, there is since added 200° adjoining, to be granted to the s^d James Logan in part of 2000° the original purchase of William & Abraham Lloyd.

Beginning at a black Oak in the line of a Tract of Land late of Owen Roberts Thence by the Same South South East 296 P^s to a post Thence West South West 316^{ps} to a black Oak ~~for a~~ Thence North by West 302 P^s to a black Oak Thence East North East 257 P^s to the place of beginning
