

Surveyd and Laid out to the London Company vist Tobias Collet &c in part of their purchase of 60000 acres. One Tract of Land in the Manner of Gilberts in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a post by the River Schuykill At a corner of Isaac Norris's Land and Running by the same North East Seven hundred sixty six perches to a corner Spanish Oak. Then North west by James Shatticks land and other Land nine hundred and Ninety perches to a Hickery tree by Shepack Creek Then west by North 180 perches to a Spanish Oak by Perqueoming Creek. Then Down the same on the Courses of thereof to the said River Schuykill then Down the said Schuykill on the Several Courses thereof to the place of Beginning Containing five thousand acres.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this tenth day of January 1917
