

I Wm. Penn proprietary and Governour of ye province of Pennsylvania in America doe hereby [at ye request of Tobias Collet Mishaell Russell Daniell Quare & Henry Gouldney] authorize and direct Thomas ffairman or any other person ye sd Tobias Collet Mishaell Russell Daniel Quare and Henry Gouldney shall appoint To survey and take up for them fifteen thousand acres of land in my sd & territorys thereof Province, with all lotts priviledges and appurtenses to ye same belonging part of 60000 acres which [amongst other things] were granted and souveyed by me unto ye said Tobias Collet Mish Russell Dan Quare & Henry Gouldney and their heirs by Indrs. of Lease and Release bearing date ye Eleventh and twelfth days of this instant August And to make returns thereof into the Surveyor Genalls Office of my sd province that ye same may from thence be Certified into my Secretarys Office my sd. Surveyor being paid his office fees and for surveying the said lands according to such agreeemt as he can or shall make with ye sd Tho. ffairman or any other Agent of ye sd Tobias Collet and ye rest provided alwayes yt if ye said land should be Surveyed or taken up without giveing tyme and reasonable notice to my sd. Surveyor Generall some tyme before ye Surveying or takeing up thereof that he or his Agent may be present at such Survey that then this my warrant or what shall be done or acted by vertue herof shall be void and of none effect Given under my hand this seventeenth day of August Anno Dni. 1699.
