At the Request of Jacob Krave That we would Grant him to take up Two hundred acres of Land on the West Side of Skuykill near that Tract which was Seated by Peter Bizallott and for some time possessed by Matthew Brooks for which he agrees to pay two and thirty pounds for the whole in one year after the date hereof with Six months Interest for the same and the yearly Quitrent of one Shilling Sterling Per hundred forever These are to Authorize and require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said Jacob Krave according to the method of Townships the said quantity of Two hundred acres of Vacant Land in the place aforesaid And make returns thereof into the Secretaries Office Which Survey in case the said Jacob fulfill the above Agreement ----- shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever Granted.
