At the request of Thomas Griffiths of Philadelphia that we would grant him a resurvey on a certain tract of land in Philadelphia County first laid out to Charles Marshall for one thousand acres but is now supposed to want of that quantity. These are therefore to authorize & require thee to resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the said tract of land according to the first lines & bounds of the same and in case of any deficiency to make good the quantity out of the nearest vacancy and make returns thereof into the Secretarys office in order for a further confirmation. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelp<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October Anno Din 1720
