If thou knowes any thing more, of Rob^t ffairmans right to ye havway house land, how deriv'd, or purchas'd, or certain w^t quantity or can further inform thyself furnish me wth it, however put that paper (thou once shew'd me) in thy pocket. I presume thou remembers it was a draft & return in ffairman & his sons hand & sign'd
