

Pursuant to five Warrants from the Commissioners of Property for surveying of lands in the Liberties of Philad^e viz^t four acres to W^m Cloud in right of W^m Bezer his Warrant dated the 3th of the sixth ^{mo.} 1716 - sixteen acres to Evan Owen in right of Thomas Rowland his Warrant dated the 9th of the eighth month 1716. Sixteen acres to James Shattick four in right of Thomas Paget and four in right of Joan Dixon both the Warrants dated the 11th of the ffourth mo 1717 and eight acres to Evan Owen -- in right of Anobl Crawly by a Warrant dated the 3^d 4^{mo.} 1717. There was survey'd and laid out the 15th day of Novem^r 1717 in the said Liberty land forty four acres being the sum of the above mentioned parcels beginning at a corner of William Palmers land and running by the same West South West eighty perches to a post then South South East sixty two perches to a post ~~then~~ in Mounce Justice's line then by the same and by vacant land East North East one hundred and sixty perches to a post then North North West forty two perches to a post then by vacant land and by the land of John Shiers eighty perches to a post then North North West twenty perches to the place of beginning containing ffifty two acres eight acres not mentioned above being survey'd to Anthony Morris in right of Sarah Hersent by a Warr^t from the Commiss^{rs} dated the 20th of the 4th mo. 1717 and made a part of the said fifty two acres
