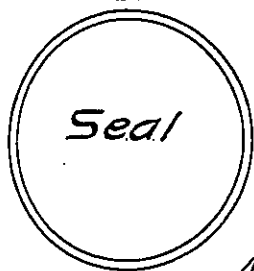

At the request of Jonathan Cockshaw and Martha his wife that we would grant them to take up the proportion of Liberty land belonging to the original purchase of four hundred acres made of ye late Proprietary by Daniel Medlicot the former husband of the said Martha to whom he bequeathed ye same. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Jonathan Cockshaw & Martha his Wife the said proportion of Liberty land where the same may be found vacant within the Liberties of Philadelphia and make returns thereof into the Secretarys office in order for a further confirmation.

Given under our hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 2^d day of 9^{br} Anno Dni 1727.
