At the Request of John Simpson of the City of London by his Attorney William Allen of Philadelphia That we would Grant him to take up the Lots of Ground within the City of Philadelphia and the proportion of Liberty Land appurtenant & belonging to fifteen hundred acres the Original purchase made of the late Proprietor by Harbert Springet of the City of London Gent. ~~the~~ by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> days of October 1681. the Right whereof being now vested in the said John Simpson. These are to authorize and Require thee to survey & lay out or cause to be survey'd & laid out unto the said John Simpson the said Lots of Ground within the City of Philadelphia where they fell by allotment or as near thereunto as may be found Vacant and the Liberty Land within the said Liberties where not already taken up and make returns thereof into the Secretary's Office.

Given under our Hands and the Lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> A.D. 1730.
