At the Request of John Simpson of the City of London by his Attorney William Allen of Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up the quantity of five hundred acres of Land in this Province the original purchase made of the late Proprietor by Harbert Springet— of the City of London Gent. by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 17th & 18th days of October Anno 1681. The Right whereof by sundry other Deeds being now vested in the said John Simpson. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto ye said John Simpson according to the method of Townships appointed (first deducting the proportion of Liberty Land) the said quantity of five hundred Acres that has not been already survey'd nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make Returne thereof into the Secretary's Office. Given under our Hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of Septemb^r Anno Din. 1730.
