At the Request of William Allen of the City of Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up the Quantity of five hundred acres of Land within the said Province the Original purchase made of the late Proprietor by William Clarke of Westminster Confectioner by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 24th & 25th dayes of April Anno 1682 the Right whereof by Sundry Deeds being now vested in the said William Allen. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said William ^{Allen} according to the method of Townships appointed (first deducting the proportion of Liberty Land) the said quantity of five hundred acres that has not been already survey'd nor appropriated nor is seated by y^e Indians and make returne thereof into the Secretary's Office. Given under our Hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of Sep^r A.D. 1730.
