


1968 Acres of Land in Right of John Tyzack Purchased
in Londn. p James Steel on his & my Joynt Acct.
James Steel & myself agree with Fran Hobson for five
hundred Acres of this Land. toward which Hobson paid
two hundred pounds

viz 100^l to J. S. & 100^l to Me.

After this J. S. ^{& wife} makes a deed for the whole 1968 Acres to me
and on a resurvey it was found that 528 Acres were cut of
the Tract for Lemerick Township and we had a warrant
for taking up 528 A. in another place my half of which 528
A. I have assigned to J. S. in Consideration of 250 Acres
he had in Co. with my Father in Bucks County. and as the
remaindr of the 1968 Acres is wholly in me I must give
J. S. a declaration of his having one Moiety of the remaindr.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
