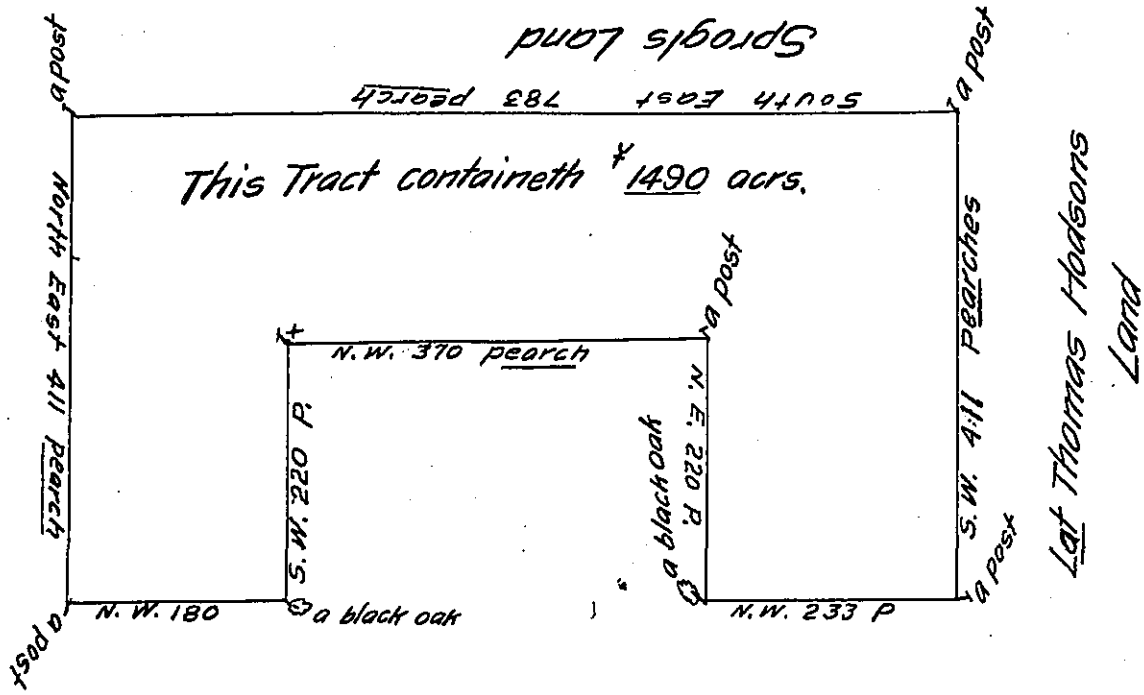

By vertue of a warrant granted to William Allen bearing date the ^{5th} first day of March in the yeare 1729 ~~13~~ in right of ^{William} ~~Sprig~~ Penn surveyed Thiss tract of Land begining at a post by the Land which was latly Thomas Hodsons then by the said: Hodsons Land south west four hundred and eleven pearches to another post by a smal black oak then south east seven hundred and eighty three pearches to a post then north east four hundred and eleven pearches to a post then northwest one hundred and eighty pearches to a black oak by ~~Marys~~ ^{Marys} Philops Land then south west two hundred and twenty pearch to a post then northwest three hundred and seventy pearch to another post by Thomas Crages Land then northeast two hundred and twenty pearches then northwest two hundred and thirty three pearch to the place of beginning containing one thousand four hundred and ninety acres surveyed in the year 1730 by —
