



James Steel Begins at a Post in Samuel Guldens line. Thence by that and Vact. Land South 40 West 265 perches to a Post in Thomas Rutter Junrs. line. Thence by that and Vact. Land N. West 320 perches to a Black oak thence by Vact Land N. 40 East 265 perches to a Black oak thence by Vact Land South East 320 perches the Place of beginning 500 acres with Allowance of Six p Cent.

March 1721. Deed from Peter Dix & Sarah his wife to J. Steel for 8 A's in Right of Tho. Powell dated 24th August 1722.

Conveyed to ye sd. Peter & Sarah by John & Joseph Powell Sons of the sd. Tho. Powel.

Deed from Tho. Chalkley to J. Steel for 8 A's of in Right of John Jones, ^{late} of London deceased whose only Sister & Heir Elisabeth Hilton Granted the same to T. Chalkley. The deed from T. C. to J. S. dated 20th May 1724.
