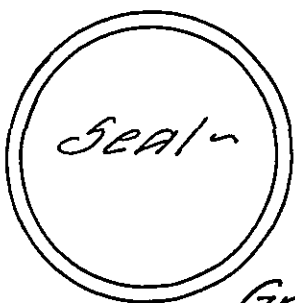


Pensylvania 5.5.



By the Commissioners of Property.
 At the Request of James Steel that we would
 Grant him to Resurvey and fix the Bounds of a Tract
 of Land laid out to Darby Green in Right of Thomas Zachary
 in the County of Philada. Containing five hundred Acres
 the Right whereof by Sundry Deeds & Conveyances being
 now vested in the said James Steel his heirs & Assignes
 These are to Authorize and Require thee to Resurvey or cause
 to be Resurveyed unto the said James Steel the said Tract
 of Land and Ascertain & fix the Lines & bounds thereof
 and make Exact Returnes of ye same into the Secretarys
 Office, Given under our hands and the lesser Seal of the
 Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of ye 4th Month A.D.
 1725.
