The High Street Lot is Situate between the 5th and 6th Streets from Schuylkill ~~from~~ bounded Southward with High Street.*

*A Lot Appurtenant to the Original Purchase of John Clare of 500<sup>as</sup>. Warrant to Morris Morris Dated the 25th. Day of May 1725 this Lot fell between Walnut and Spruce Street and between the Second & Third Streets from Schuylkill.*

*A Lot Appurtenant to the Original purchase of John Snashold 500<sup>as</sup>. Warrt. Dated the 22<sup>d</sup>. of December 1727. this Lot fell between the 2d. & 3d. Streets from Schuylkill and between Sassafras Street & Vine Street.*

*A Lot Appurtenant to the Original Purchase of John Jones. 500<sup>as</sup>. Warrt to Thomas Chalkley Dated the 5th of September 1720. this Lot fell between the Second and Third Streets from Schuylkill, and between Sassafras Street and Nine Street.*

*A Lot Appurtenant to the original purchase of Henry Barnard, this Lot fell between Walnut and Chesnut Street. and between the 6th & 7th Streets from Schuylkill. See Thomas Chalkley's Deed to James Steel there is no Warrant for the laying out this Lot.*

*A Lot Appurtenant to the Original purchase of of Herbert Springet see a Deed from Wm. Allen to James Steel. this Lot fell between Walnut Street and Spruce Street and between the 2d & 3d Streets from Schuylkill.*
