



The above draft included in the black lines is a part of Lot No. 46 in the 3<sup>d</sup> district Donation lands being an undrawn tract of Donation Land 51<sup>st</sup> date in Mercer County Lachowanock Township on the waters of Little Nes-anach surveyed for James Gault the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March A. D. 1822 containing one hundred and two acres 58 perches with the Allowance.

This tract has been settled by George Davis according to the requisition of the Law for the sale of undrawn Donation Lands. The dotted lines embrace the residue of the Tract.

Mr. James Gault intends taking out a patent for his part to which the seller is agreed.
